

### **PRIVACY POLICY**



#### INTRODUCTION

Hesson Consultancy Limited ("we, us, our") comply with the New Zealand Privacy Act 2020 when dealing with personal information. It applies to all personal information that we collect, process, or receive. This may be in person or via our website at <a href="www.katehesson.com">www.katehesson.com</a> ("the Website"), email, social media, apps, over the phone, or through other channels.

Personal information is information about an identifiable individual (a natural person), and includes personal data, personally identifiable information and equivalent information under applicable privacy and data protection laws.

This policy does not limit or exclude any of your rights under the New Zealand Privacy Act 2020. For further information on the New Zealand Privacy Act 2020, see www.privacy.org.nz.

This policy was drafted with brevity and clarity in mind. It does not provide exhaustive detail of all aspects of our collection and use of personal information. ### WHEN DOES THIS PRIVACY POLICY APPLY

This privacy policy applies to personal information we collect from visitors to our Website, our customers and other persons with whom we deal directly.

### **CHILDREN**

Where we collect personal information from or about children aged under 16 for the purposes of providing our services, we rely on representations from customers that they have appropriate individual or parental consent for any such children.

### WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT

We will collect your personal information where you choose to provide it. The type of personal information we collect depends on the nature of our relationship with you.

When you visit our Website, we do not collect any personal information about you, except to the limited extent through the use of cookies.

When you fill in a contact or enquiry form on our Website, call us, meet us in person or otherwise contact us, we collect your name, email address, phone number and any other information you choose to provide to us.

When you sign up to our newsletter and other electronic alerts, we collect your name, email address, phone number, user preferences and any other information you provide to us when you ask to receive our newsletter or other alerts. You can unsubscribe from them at any time.

When you respond to our feedback surveys, we collect your name, email address, date of birth, demographic information and any other information you choose to include in your response.

When you purchase services from us, we may collect your name, date of birth, email address, phone number, credit card information, and any other information you submit to us for billing and order fulfilment purposes.

Where you provide us with your personal information, you agree to allow our use of this information as detailed in this Privacy Policy. We try to only collect the personal information necessary to fulfil your request. We will notify you where the information we ask for is additional or optional.

Some of the personal information that we collect directly from you may be mandatory and some may be optional. We will let you know which of these applies at the time we collect the relevant personal information. While you do not have to provide us with some of the information that we may request, this might mean that our services may not perform as well as they should, or that we may not be able to provide some parts of the website or all of our services to you. When you access and use our Website or related services we may automatically collect information about your device and usage of our Website, products and services, including your IP address, operating system, browser type, time spent on certain pages of the website, pages visited, links clicked and language preferences.

Some of this data is collected through third party tools and/or the use of cookies, web beacons and similar storage technologies. Please refer to our cookie policy below for further information, including information on how you can disable these technologies.

We deliver some email updates via independent mail management company Mailchimp.

Mailchimp provides analytics to us on how people interact with our newsletters (eg, how many subscribers have opened emails or clicked on links). This means that we and Mailchimp will be able to see your name, email address and details about which links in our newsletters you have clicked on. We only use this information to assess newsletter effectiveness.

# HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may use your personal information to:

- verify your identity
- provide our Website, products and services to you
- provide you with documentation
- market our products and services to you, including contacting you electronically (e.g. by text or email for this purpose)
- improve our Website, products and services
- publish things on our Website (e.g. comments on pages)

- run promotions (e.g. referral and loyalty programmes, surveys and contests)
- bill you and collect money that you owe us, including authorising and processing credit card transactions
- respond to communications from you, including enquiries and complaints
- conduct research and statistical analysis
- tailor content or advertisements on our Website
- protect and/or enforce our legal rights and interests, including defending any claim
- respond to lawful requests by public authorities, including to comply with law enforcement requirements, or
- for any other purpose authorised by you or applicable law.

We may transfer your information in the case of a sale, merger, consolidation, liquidation, reorganisation or acquisition.

### **DISCLOSING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION**

We may disclose your personal information to:

- any business that supports (or delivers services you have requested in connection with) our
  website, products and services, including any person that hosts or maintains any underlying
  IT system or data centre that we use to provide our Website, products or services or that we
  use to process payments
- a credit reference agency for the purpose of credit checking you
- third parties (for anonymised statistical information)
- professional advisers e.g. accountants, lawyers or auditors
- a person who can require us to supply your personal information (e.g. a law enforcement agency or regulatory authority)
- any other person with your consent
- any other company in the case of a sale, merger, consolidation, liquidation, re-organisation
   or acquisition
- any other person authorised by applicable law.

Also, we may share information about your use of our Website with our trusted advertising and analytics partners through the use of cookies, web beacons, and similar storage technologies. Please refer to our Cookie Policy below for further information.

### INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

A business that supports our Website, products and services or delivers services that we sell as agent may be located outside of New Zealand (the country where we are incorporated) and also outside of the country where you are located. This means that the personal information we collect may be transferred to, and stored in, a country outside of New Zealand and the country where you are located. Therefore, we cannot guarantee that the same standards apply in that country as apply in New Zealand. By proceeding to give us your personal information, you acknowledge and consent to this arrangement.

### PROTECTING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

As required by applicable law, we will take steps to keep your personal information safe from loss, unauthorised activity, or other misuse. You play an important role in keeping your personal information secure by maintaining the confidentiality of any password and accounts used in relation to our products and services. You should not disclose any such password to third parties. Please notify us immediately if there is any unauthorised use of your account or any other breach of security.

## **ACCESSING AND CORRECTING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION**

Subject to certain grounds for refusal under applicable law, you have the right to access your personal information that we hold and to request a correction to your personal information. Before you exercise this right, we will need evidence to confirm that you are the individual to whom the personal information relates.

Where you request a correction, if we think the correction is reasonable and we are reasonably able to

change your personal information, we will make the correction. In all other cases, we will take reasonable

steps to make a note of the personal information that was the subject of your correction request.

information over the internet, the provision of that information is at your own risk.

**DATA RETENTION POLICY** 

The personal information that we collect and use is not intended to be kept longer than necessary for the

purposes for which it is collected. Generally, we will keep personal information we collect for no longer

than six months unless the law requires that we keep it for longer.

### LAWFUL BASIS FOR PROCESSING PERSONAL INFORMATION

Our lawful basis for processing your personal information that we collect, use and disclose depends on the personal information collected and the context in which we collect it.

Generally, we collect personal information from you where we have your consent, where processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which you are party or in order to take steps at your request prior to entering into a contract, or where processing is necessary for the purposes of our legitimate interests (except where such interests are overridden by your interests or fundamental rights and freedoms).

Where we process personal information based on your consent, you may withdraw your consent at any time.

Despite the above, we may process your personal information where such processing is necessary for compliance with applicable laws.

# **YOUR RIGHTS**

Your rights in relation to your personal information include:

- right of access if you ask us, we will confirm whether we are processing your personal information and provide you with a copy of that personal information.
- right to rectification if the personal information we hold about you is inaccurate or incomplete, you have the right to have it rectified or completed. We will take reasonable steps to ensure inaccurate personal information is rectified. If we have shared your personal information with any third party, we will tell them about the rectification where possible.

- right to erasure when your personal information is no longer needed for the purposes for
  which you provided it, we will delete it. You may request that we delete your personal
  information and we will do so if deletion does not contravene any applicable law. If we have
  shared your personal data with any third party, we will take reasonable steps to inform those
  third parties that they must delete your personal information.
- right to withdraw consent if the basis of our processing of your personal information is consent, you can withdraw that consent at any time.
- right to restrict processing you may request that we restrict or block the processing of your
  personal information in certain circumstances. If we have shared your personal information
  with any third party, we will tell them about this request where possible.
- right to object to processing you may request that we stop processing your personal information at any time and we will do so to the extent required by applicable law.
- rights related to automated decision-making, including profiling you have the right to not be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you, except where such automated decision-making is necessary for entering into, or the performance of, a contract with you, is authorised by applicable laws or is based on your explicit consent. We do not undertake automated individual decision-making.
- right to data portability you may obtain your personal information from us that you have
  consented to give us or that is necessary to perform a contract with you. We will provide
  this personal information in a commonly used, machine-readable and interoperable format
  to enable data portability to another data controller. Where technically feasible, and at your
  request, we will transmit your personal information directly to another data controller.
- the right to complain to a supervisory authority you can report any concern you have about our privacy practices to your local data protection authority.

Where personal information is processed for the purposes of direct marketing, you have the right to object to such processing, including profiling related to direct marketing.

### **COOKIE POLICY**

### INTRODUCTION

We may use cookies on our website and as part of our related services, and receive information collected through cookies. This cookie policy explains how we use cookies and how you can opt out of them.

By continuing to use our Website and related services, you indicate your agreement for us to use the cookies described below.

### WHAT ARE COOKIES

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your browsing device, e.g. a computer or smartphone, when you visit a website. Cookies can be recognised by the website that downloaded them, or by other websites that use the same cookies. This helps a website know if the browsing device has visited that or another website before.

Cookies can be used to collect information relating to your use of a website or your device, let you navigate between pages effectively, help to remember your preferences and generally improve your browsing experience. Cookies can also help ensure advertising you see online is more relevant to you and your interests.

Cookies can be *session* or *persistent* cookies. *Session* cookies are temporary and only stay on your browser until you stop browsing. *Persistent* cookies stay on your device until they expire or are deleted.

The cookies used on our Website may be first party cookies (i.e. set by us) or third party cookies (i.e. cookies set on our website by a person other than us). The third party companies that place cookies on our Website will have their own privacy policies.

### WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE

Any types of cookies we use are essential for the full functionality of our website and related services. They enable you to navigate around our Website and services and use their features e.g. accessing secure

areas and enabling services that you have asked to receive. If you opt out of these cookies, you may not be able to access all the functions of our Website and some services that you have asked to receive.

# **CONTROL OR OPT OUT OF COOKIES**

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. However, if you do this, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit our Website and attempt to use our services, you may not be able to access certain parts of our Website or services, and some functionalities may not work.
